

Day 1: Fly overnight to Italy

Day 2: Rome

 Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other.

Day 3: Rome

- Take an expert-led tour of Vatican City. Marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard, protectors of the independent city-state.
- Visit the Sistine Chapel.
- Visit St. Peter's Basilica.
- Time to see more of Rome or
 enjoy a cooking class.

Day 4: Rome

- Explore the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat. Nearby, the Roman Forum marks the former heart of the Roman Empire. Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches there. Before you say "arrivederci" to Rome, toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City.
- Take an expert-led tour of Rome.
- Visit the Colosseum.
- Visit the Roman Forum.
- Take a self-guided walking tour of Rome: Trevi Fountain; Pantheon; Piazza Navona; Spanish Steps.

Day 5: Rome | Paris

- Fly to Paris, the City of Light, where you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Île de la Cité; Conciergerie; Sainte-Chapelle.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.
- Enjoy a Seine River cruise.

Day 6: Paris

- Take an expert-led tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower.
- Time to see more of Paris or

• visit Versailles.

Day 7: Paris | Madrid

- Fly to Madrid, the capital and largest city in Spain. Explore Puerta del Sol, the heart of the city, and travel back in time to Spain's Golden Age at Plaza Mayor. You'll learn about this grand square's history of bullfights, royal weddings, and public executions. At the Prado art museum, behold paintings like Velázquez's *Las Meninas* and Goya's paired canvases. Get a taste of royal Madrid at the extravagant Palacio Real, where you'll wander the fabulous palace interior and find more than 2,000 rooms decked in beautiful frescoes, delicate porcelain wares, and finely woven rugs.
- Take a walking tour of Madrid.

- Visit the Prado.
- Time to see more of Madrid or
- visit Toledo.

- Tour the Quinta de Regaleira palace with an expert local guide.
- Explore the Mercado Da Ribeira on a market challenge to build a feast of authentic Portuguese cuisine.
